

## 2002 – WCC Mission Statement Review

- The WCC Strategic Plan calls for a periodic review of the college's purpose statement. The last review was completed in 1998 and changes implemented in 1999.
- In September 2002, a subcommittee from the WCC Planning Council completed their review of the purpose/mission statement, which began in March 2002. The subcommittee's responsibility was to ensure that the college's purpose/mission is student centered and in-line with the accountability standards outlined in the WCC Strategic Plan.
- The following information shows the changes to the existing purpose/mission statement and the revised mission statement. The Administrative Council approved the revised statement on September 16, 2002. The revised mission statement will be effective July 2003.

### Current Purpose/Mission Statement
