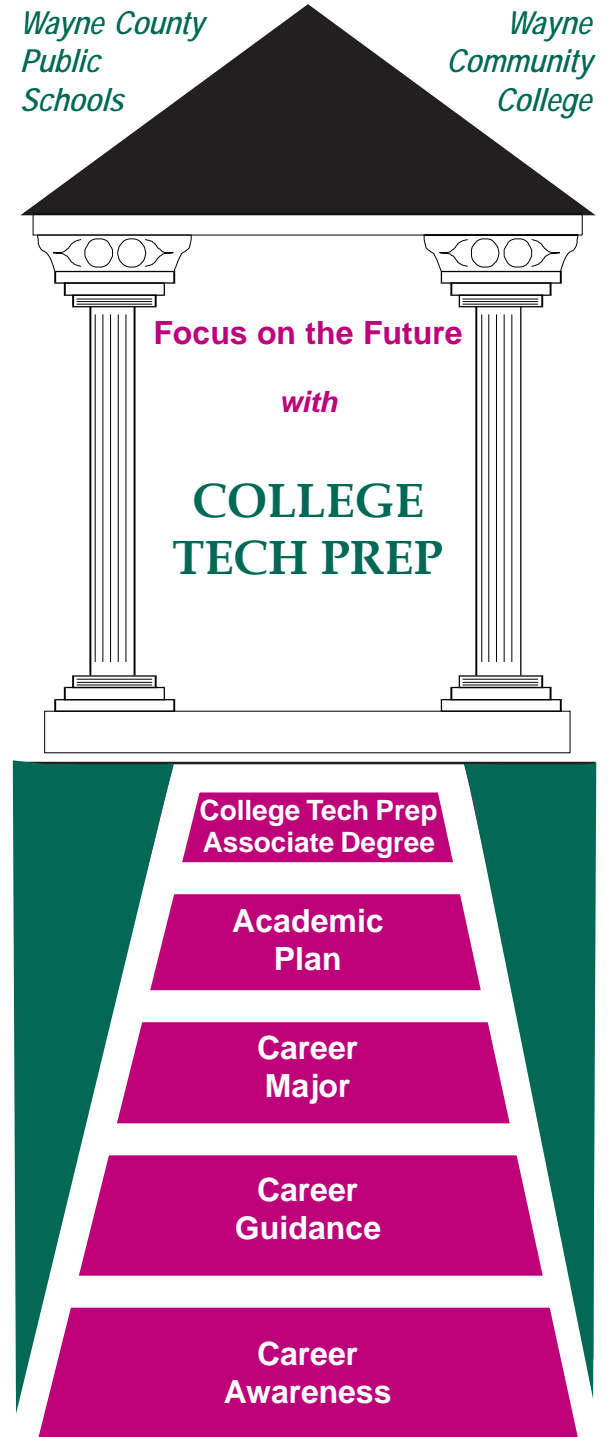

# College Tech Prep

## What is it?

- A course of study for technical careers
- A blending of academic and career courses which allows transition to two- or four-year college programs

## Why do we need it?

- 85% of all jobs will require more than a high school diploma.
- 65% of all jobs require specialized job skills, but not a four-year college degree.

## When do I start?

- **NOW!** The sooner you begin, the better your opportunity of fitting all prerequisite courses into your high school schedule, and the better your chance of earning articulated placement credit at the community college level.
- College Tech Prep students are encouraged to select a major by the 9th grade but not later than the 11th grade.

## How do I begin?

- Talk to your Career Development Coordinator or Guidance Counselor. They can offer you interest and aptitude testing if you are not sure what you want to do.
- They can also talk to you about programs available at Wayne Community College and other North Carolina Community Colleges. Be sure to consult the Wayne Community College/Wayne County Schools Articulation Agreement to plan for articulated placement credit.
- Work with your Counselor/CDC to complete/revise your academic plan.
