

A Resolution in Support of a 100% Tobacco-Free Campus Policy at Wayne Community College

WHEREAS, The Student Government Association of Wayne Community College is concerned about ensuring a safe and healthy learning and working environment on our campus.

WHEREAS, we believe that safe and healthy schools are essential learning environments and are the right of students, faculty and staff; and

WHEREAS, the administration of Wayne Community College is responsible for promoting and protecting the health of students, staff, and visitors while on campus; and

WHEREAS, tobacco use on college campuses is a serious health issue in North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, a tobacco-free campus policy prohibits tobacco use by anyone on campus grounds; and

WHEREAS, many colleges across the country – including many in North Carolina – have already adopted comprehensive tobacco-free policies;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Student Government Association of Wayne Community College encourages the administration of Wayne Community College to adopt a 100% tobacco-free campus policy that prohibits tobacco use on campus and commits the support of the Student Government Association to the tobacco-free initiative.
