Position duties:

The biology instructor is responsible for teaching an average of 15-21 contact hours per Instructional duties include teaching day and evening as well as online courses in the general biology, environmental biology, and the anatomy and physiology sequences, as well as related courses. Laboratory responsibilities include instruction, facility supervision, ordering supplies, laboratory preparation and maintenance. Additional duties include advising students, serving on committees, and participation in faculty meetings, convocation, graduation and recruitment activities. student recruitment and retention, including college-wide marketing initiatives is required.
