Position duties:

The Psychology instructor is responsible for teaching an average of 18-21 hours per semester. Instructional duties include teaching day and/or evening courses in psychology. Classes meet on the main campus and at Seymour Johnson Air Force Base. The college also offers online courses in psychology. Responsibilities include on-site and online instruction; course development where applicable; timely submission of reports; participation in assigned committees; participation in committee textbook selection; service in the College Transfer Advising Center; participation in required special events including faculty meetings, orientation, and graduation; recruitment activities; participation in planning processes; and adherence to achieving learning outcomes.

If selected for employment, the applicant must submit to a criminal background check and drug screening.
