Preference will be given to North Carolina community college students. All scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time at East Carolina University.

To be considered for the transfer scholarship program, a student must apply and be eligible for admission to East Carolina University. Selection for the scholarships will be made based upon the academic credentials received with the application for admission and a completed Transfer Scholarship Application. The deadline is March I. All required materials must be received no later than March I. Only application materials postmarked by the United States Postal Service (USPS) on or before the March I deadline will be processed. Private carriers' date stamps (UPS, FedEx, personal or business postage meters, etc.) will not be considered official.
