- Take placement tests or submit SAT or ACT scores or submit HS GPA that meets state requirement and complete an acceptance interview with a WCC counselor.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- 5. Demonstrate strong academic performance and potential for success in the program through the submission of all transcripts from high school and colleges or universities attended with admission application.
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA and pass 67% of credits attempted while enrolled at Wayne Community College.
- Re-apply for the Top 10 Scholarship annually. This scholarship does not renew automatically.
