TOP 10 2014-2015 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA

An individual with an interest in receiving a Top 10 Scholarship and pursuing a career in one of the ten programs identified must do the following:

1. Complete the Wayne Community College admission application
2. Complete the Wayne Community College Top 10 Scholarship application. **Submit a letter stating his/her career goals and reason for selecting this career path.**
3. Take placement tests or submit SAT or ACT scores or submit HS GPA that meets state requirement and complete an acceptance interview with a WCC counselor.
4. Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
5. Demonstrate strong academic performance and potential for success in the program through the submission of all transcripts from high school and colleges or universities attended with admission application.
6. Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA and pass 67% of credits attempted while enrolled at Wayne Community College.
7. Re-apply for the Top 10 Scholarship annually. This scholarship does not renew automatically.
