Position requirements:

A Master's degree in Mathematics or Master's degree with 18 graduate semester hours in mathematics is required. The following requirements are preferred: knowledge and experience with the use of technology, math software, MyMathLab, and the graphing calculator; experience teaching and designing math curricula to teach online math courses using Moodle; experience in the use of retention practices, student learning outcomes, and working with a diverse student population; and experience teaching Calculus and Statistics. One to three years of teaching experience at the post-secondary level is preferred. Experience in teaching online courses is preferred. Excellent oral and written communication skills are required.

Position duties:

The curriculum mathematics instructor is responsible for teaching an average of 15-22 credit hours per semester. Instructional duties include teaching day, evening, weekend, and online courses in curriculum math. Classes meet on the main campus and at Seymour Johnson Air Force Base. Responsibilities include advising students, course development where applicable and timely submission of reports. The instructor is required to participate on committees, in committee textbook selection, in the College Transfer Advising Center, in planning processes and professional development opportunities. Attendance is required at faculty meetings, orientation, graduation and all other scheduled events. The instructor will be involved in recruitment activities. Adherence to achieving learning outcomes is expected.

If selected for employment, the applicant must submit to a criminal background check and drug screening.
