



In 2005, Simpson received the state's highest civilian honor, the North Carolina Award in Fine Arts.

Jack Herrick has served since 1979 as artistic director, composer and performer for The Red Clay Ramblers. He wrote the book, music, and lyrics for the children's musical Bah! Humbug!, Johnny and the Apple, and Rip Van Winkle and the Legend of Sleepy Hollow commissioned and produced by the St. Louis Repertory Theatre.
