****IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE ON FINANCIAL AID WARNING OR PROBATION****

If your SAP status is financial aid warning or probation on appeal, your summer financial aid will not be processed by the payment deadline. Your eligibility for continued financial aid cannot be determined until all spring grades are reviewed. Spring grades are due on May 9, 2019. All required processes to determine satisfactory academic progress status for financial aid purposes will not be completed by the payment deadline; therefore, if you register for summer courses, you must pay the tuition and fees by the published payment deadline of May 13, 2019 to avoid having your schedule purged for non-payment. You may wish to consider enrollment in the Nelnet Payment Plan. *NOTE – you may check your SAP status on WebAdvisor/Self-Service.*

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – SUMMER FINANCIAL AID

- The **2018-2019 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)** must be completed for Summer 2019 financial aid. If you do not have an application on file with WCC, visit fafsa.gov. The deadline to file is June 30, 2019.
- Summer awards may not be available until mid-April.
- Eligibility to receive a summer Pell Grant is based on the availability of funds for the 2018-2019 academic year, enrollment status, SAP status, indebtedness to the college, and class attendance.
- **Students must be accepted into an approved certificate, diploma, or associate degree program at WCC to qualify for financial aid.** Dual-enrolled high school students, special credit and/or visiting students are not eligible for financial aid.
- If you received Federal Pell Grant funds for Fall 2018 and/or Spring 2019, but did not receive a full-time payment for one or both semesters, you may have 2018-2019 grant funds remaining for summer. Any funds available for summer will be awarded automatically EXCEPT for students who are on Financial Aid Warning or Probation. Summer financial aid will show on WebAdvisor/Self-Service when available.
- If you were enrolled full-time for both Fall 2018 and Spring 2019, **you must enroll for at least 6 credit hours** to qualify for additional summer funding. If your credit hours are split over Summer I and Summer II, you may not receive funds until the Summer II session begins. The Financial Aid Office will determine your eligibility after summer registration has been completed.
- **Full-time status for the Federal Pell Grant is 12 or more credit hours.** Enrollment in less than 12 credit hours will cause aid to be prorated. In some cases, the prorated amount may be less than the cost of tuition and students should be prepared to pay the difference. Please contact a Financial Aid representative if you have any questions.
- Under no circumstances may a student receive more than 150% of his/her scheduled Pell Grant award in an academic year. ****If our office receives information that a student has exceeded the annual maximum because of aid received at another institution during the 2018-2019 academic year, the student will be required to return all, or a portion of, the aid received at WCC.**
- As with fall and spring semesters, Pell Grant funds for the summer are credited to student accounts based on enrollment status at the 10% point of the semester. Financial aid funds cannot be used to pay for no-shows/never attends, audits, or test outs/credit by exam. Financial aid for students reported as having received one of these statuses will be reduced or eliminated accordingly and the student will be responsible for any outstanding charges on his/her account.
- If it becomes necessary to change your class schedule after registering for the summer term, all adjustments must be made by officially dropping or withdrawing from the course(s) by the dates posted in the Summer Schedule of Courses. **Financial Aid recipients are strongly encouraged to consult with a Financial Aid representative to determine how schedule adjustments may affect the financial aid award.**
- **Only credit hours associated with required coursework are considered eligible for federal aid purposes.** Classes that do not fulfill major or elective requirements for your program of study will not be counted when determining your enrollment status for financial aid eligibility.
- If anticipated financial aid is **NOT** awarded, the student will be responsible for any balance due on his/her account.
- Students who are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for the summer Pell Grant should be prepared to pay any outstanding balance to the Cashier's Office OR enroll in a payment plan by 4:00 pm on May 13, 2019 (or *May 20, 2019 for late registration*). Failure to pay the outstanding balance by the due date will result in the cancellation of all registered classes.
- Award letters will not be mailed to continuing students for the 2019 summer term. You may review your revised award letter on WebAdvisor/Self-Service. Any other correspondence regarding eligibility for summer aid will be mailed to the address on file with the Office of Admissions and Records. ****Students are responsible for ensuring that the correct information is on file.**
