Wayne Community College's mission is to meet the educational, training, and cultural needs of the communities it serves.



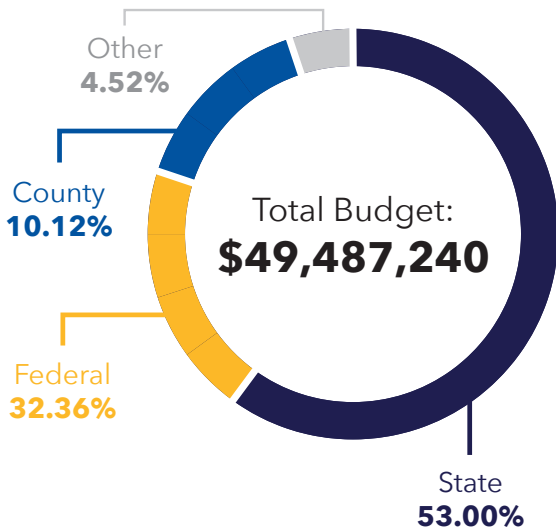

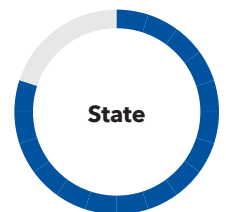

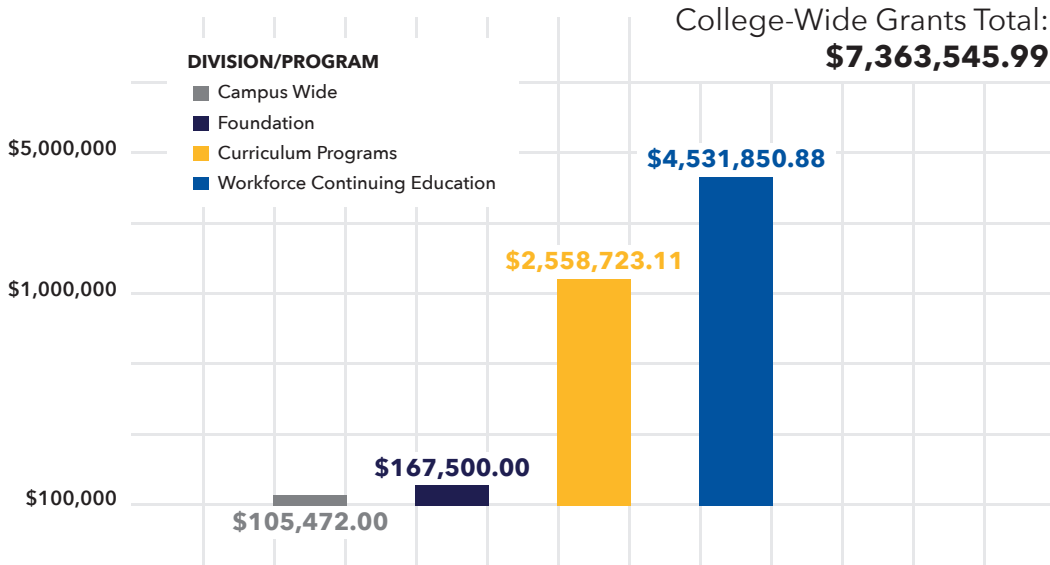

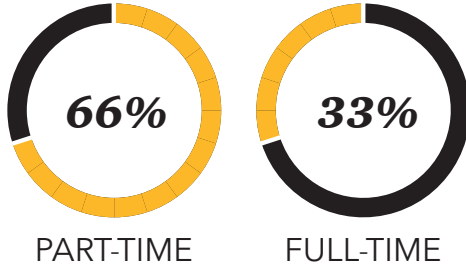
