TUITION AND FEES REFUND POLICY

In accordance with NCAC 2D.0202, a refund can not be made except under the following circumstances:

1) A 100 percent refund shall be made if the student officially withdraws prior to the first day of class(es) or the academic semester as noted in the college calendar. Also, a student is eligible for a 100 percent refund if the class in which the student is officially registered fails to "make" due to insufficient enrollment. 2) A 75 percent refund shall be made if the student officially withdraws from the class(es) prior to or on the official 10 percent point of the semester. (May 31) 3) For classes beginning at times other than the first week (seven calendar days) of the semester, a 100 percent refund shall be made if the student officially withdraws from the class prior to the first class meeting. A 75 percent refund shall be made if the student officially withdraws from the class prior to or on the 10 percent point of the class.
