- ☞ Apply early to maximize awards. **2019-2020 FAFSA available now**
- ☞ Be thorough. You are your own biggest advocate.
- ☞ Be "in the know". Know your log in for FAFSA and Webadvisor so you can check out self-service.

What You Need to Know

The 2019-2020 FAFSA became available on October 1st. This application is for the next academic year. We suggest that if attending for the 19-20 year, you complete the FAFSA now to maximize awards. Things you will need:

- ☞ 2017 tax information
- ☞ Email: For FSA ID purposes we suggest students use a personal email
- ☞ Dependent students will need to provide parent information & parents must use a separate email from student.

Are You In the Know?

Remember your FSA ID. Know your Webadvisor log in. You can find out most information by checking your Webadvisor including: awards, refunds, and SAP status

It's Not too Late...

To complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA covering Fall 2018 through Summer 2019. You will need the following

- ☞ 2016 tax information
- ☞ Email: For FSA ID purposes we suggest students use a personal email
- ☞ Dependent students will need to provide parent information & parents must use a separate email from student.

If you have submitted the 2018-2019 FAFSA application, check your status with the Financial Aid Office. If you are eligible for financial aid, we will not be able to award if verification isn't completed.
