	A court determined me to be an emancipated minor. (53)	Court documents from your legal state of residence confirming your legal emancipation before your 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday.	
	I was in a legal guardianship with someone other than my biological parent and/or stepparent immediately before my 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday. (54)	Court documents from your legal state of residence confirming the legal guardianship. (NOTE – Papers must indicate legal guardianship; legal custody does not qualify)	
	On or after July 1, 2019, I was determined to be either an unaccompanied youth who was homeless OR a self-supporting youth who was at risk of being homeless.
