	I am a Veteran who is 26 years of age or older and served in the U.S. Armed Forces, <u>excluding</u> the Reserves, National Guard or Delayed Entry pool.	Copy of your DD Form 214, "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty."
	I was not able to register because I was hospitalized, incarcerated, and/or institutionalized before the age of 18 and remained confined through my 26 <sup>th</sup> birthday.	Hospitalization, incarceration, or institutional records documenting the length of confinement.
	I am a non-U.S. male who first entered this country after my 26 <sup>th</sup> birthday.	Passport with a date of entry stamp, I-94 with date of entry stamp or a letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) indicating the date you entered the U.S.
	I am a non-U.S. male in this country on a valid non-immigrant visa.	Copy of your I-20 form <b>OR</b> a letter from a school you attended on an F-1 Student Visa indicating your full-time attendance as a non-immigrant alien.

I am a citizen of the Federal States of Micronesia, or the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Republic of Palau and have not lived in the U.S. for more than one year for any reason except as a student or employee of the government of my homeland.	Copy of your unexpired passport
